



CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE


The massive earthquake in Nepal in April & May 2015, followed by a strong aftershock and hundred more since then. The earthquakes and aftershocks from time to time over two months shook Nepal caused considerable damage to many parts of Khumbu region including the monastery like Khumjung Gompa. Detail survey was requested to carry out to assess the overall damaged conditions. The assessment report stated that there have been major cracks and distortion of structures at multiple sites, which required reconstruction of the whole building.



To this end, a rebuild committee was formed with primary responsible to rebuild the Gompa and the committee has begun to raise funds and explore potential donors within local, national and international levels who could provide financial assistance to rebuild those damaged structures. In order to assist the main, rebuild committee, Sub-committee was formed in Kathmandu with primary responsible to help in fund raising and communication help. The sub-committee in Kathmandu has appointed Mr. Pasang Dawa Sherpa of Khumjung – 1 as the coordinator for Kathmandu based rebuilds committee.

The Samten Choling Gompa Management Committee was successful in raising funds within local, international communities, donor agencies as well as the labor contributions for the completion of the rebuild project. The Khumjung Gompa Rebuild Committee express our great appreciation to all the respected donor agencies, local and international communities, local people for your assistance in rebuild of the Gompa. Your emotional kindness and the strength you have given us was very important and valid specially during those difficult time. It is with such generous support that Khumjung Gompa was successful in completion of the rebuild project in August 2017. Hence, the Samten Choling Gompa was successful in inauguration on 19th August 2017.

The Samten Chholing Gompa Management Committee was successful in organizing the event of inauguration ceremony that has taken place at Samten Choling Gompa at Khumjung on 19th August 2017. INTRODUCTION

The Samten Choling Gompa Management Committee is pleased to present this final updates as of August 2017 to all our respected and loving donors who had generously provided their financial support to rebuild and restore the Samten Choling Monastery (Gompa) in Khumjung village. The Samten Choling Gompa was severely damaged from April and May 2015 earthquake that suffered terrible damage to religious structures and monuments of this region. For the Sherpas of this village, their natural and cultural heritage is an important component of their identity.

Realizing the need to rebuild and restore the damaged of this Gompa in mind, with active motivation and strong commitment from Khumjung and Khunde community, the Samten Choling Gompa Management Committee has formed special committee named: Khumjung Gompa Rebuild Committee based in Khumjung and Sub-Rebuild Committee in Kathmandu with primary responsible to assess the condition and possible raise funds to rebuild the severely damaged Gompa. The Samten Choling Gompa rebuild committee based in Khumjung and in Kathmandu had successfully raised funding from friends and donors from national and international communities and labor contributions from Khumjung and Khunde Community that enabled to complete the rebuild of Khumjung Gompa within the given time. The committee based in Kathmandu had already presented an update and mid-term reports in November 2016 and April 2017 accordingly to the respected donors with overall progress has made with expense details at the time of those preparations of the reports.

BACKGROUND OF SAMTEN CHOLING GOMPA

Samten Choling Monastery falls within the Sagarmatha National Park-a UNESCO World Heritage Site is located in the beautiful landscape of Khumjung village (Khumbu Pasang Lhamu Village Municipality Ward-4 Khumjung) at the foot of the sacred peak (Khumbila at an altitude of 3790m. Khumjung also forms the entry point of “Sacred Sites Trail Project” a circular trek inside the park, passing clockwise through ten monasteries, caves, hermitages and nunneries, starting from Namche Bazar. Khumjung village is the largest settlement with population of approximately 110 in total of 300 households is the most famous for hidden, sacred valley known as Beyul more than 1,200 years by Guru Rimpoche (Padmadambhava).

The Sherpas of this region believe it is a place of refuge, peace, and special spiritual qualities. Samten Choling Gompa is one of the oldest monasteries in the Khumbu valley approximately 360 years old where the skull of Yeti or the abominable snowman is preserved and displayed. Khumjung Gompa is also known for its precious old religious books and artefacts. Its beautiful paintings and statues were created by artists who had migrated into Khumjung from Mustang valley.

SAMTEN CHOLING GOMPA **REBUILD COMPLETED**

Following the 2015 earthquake, the rebuild committee based in Khumjung had consulted and hired local engineering expert to enter the affected areas to assess the damaged conditions of cultural properties, prepare preliminary restoration plans, and estimate the restoration costs with earthquake proofing plans. The assessment report stated that there has been major cracks and distortion of structures at multiple sites, which required reconstruction of the whole building. After obtaining the assessment report and the cost estimation from local based engineering expert, the rebuild committee based in Khumjung and in Kathmandu began to raise funds and collection of timber, stone and sand collection, aggregate collection, timber and stone work began from May 2016. The main rebuild process began only after the completion of the annual Dumji¹ and Nyingne² celebration in June 2016 with full support of the local communities from Khumjung and Khunde including the committee formed both in Khumjung and in Kathmandu to undertake the rebuild process.



¹ Dumji is a great festival in which the whole community takes part. It has been in practice for more than 300 years during the monsoon season. The local representatives provide food and drink for the whole community for 5 days. The responsibility for this festival falls on every household once or twice in a lifetime depending on the number of houses in each village. On this occasion rich and poor join the celebration on equal terms. Monks from Tengboche Gompa are invited to recite the ceremony. The main purpose of Dumji is two-fold: it is both a request to various gods' power to subdue demonic enemies of the village and a celebration of the anniversary of the death of the patron saint Lama Sanga Dorji.

² Nyingne is performed at the end of May or early June in village Gompas. The main purpose of this festival is to cleanse the worshippers of sin and to help them obtain more Sonam (merit). This rite requires a lama, generally the Head Lama from Tengboche, to oversee it. The participants recite prayers along with the lama on the first day. The second day, everyone fasts and they do not speak to one another. Finally, on the third day after obtaining a blessing from the lama, they depart back to their own houses.

The fund received by the rebuild committee went directly to rebuild the Samten Choling Monastery of Khumbu Pasang Lhamu Village Municipality Ward-4 Khumjung. As a result, the Samten Choling Gompa has successfully completed in August 2017 after 15 months of work. The Samten Choling Gompa Management Committee is pleased to report to all the respected donors, individual friends and communities from national and international that the Gompa has been successfully completed in August 2017.

WORKING AREA AND **BENEFICIARIES AND PARTICIPANTS**



The rebuild of Samten Choling Gompa (Monastery) lies in the Khumbu Pasang Lhamu Village Municipality Ward-4 Khumjung within Sagarmatha National Park a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Approximately 4000 local Sherpas living inside the park and approximately 40,000 tourists as well as their support parties would directly or indirectly benefit from this cultural conservation and restoration endeavor. Gompas are an important source of spiritual guidance to the local communities.



There are approximately 300 households with population of 1100 in Khumjung and Khunde and all those people share this Gompa for religious festivals such as the annual religious festival like Dumji and Nyingne twice a year where the local people take a turn. In the future, more cultural tourism will lead to increased funding and support for monasteries which will, in turn, keep these important repositories of collective memory, ritual, and tradition alive.



LOCAL PARTNERS

The key local level program partners such as the community based organizations i.e., the mothers group from Khumjung and Khunde, the youth group from Khumjung, the Khunde Community Club, the lamas from Khunde Gompa and the Khumjung Gompa Welfare Development Committee were instrumental in supporting through out the rebuild process especially during the implementation period at the ground levels. The Sagarmatha National Park and Buffer Zone, Khumbila Buffer Zone Management Committee and the Village Development Committee were the another supporting partners as well.

BREAK THROUGH AND CHALLENGES

Over its lifespan, the Samten Choling Gompa (Khumjung) was extended several times. Its original small size and weak foundation required much renovation and restoration. The last renovation was completed in 2000 with hard work of local community members from Khunde and Khumjung and the 2015 earthquake again worsen the condition as the Gompa was severely damaged.

The Samten Choling Gompa rebuild committee was successful in engaging the three teams mobilized to speed up the work even during the winter time. As a result, the first and second floor of courtyard (Dhewang) was possible for completion. During the rebuild process, one of the major challenges the rebuild committee faced was to restore the traditional, but aging architecture and infrastructures including the statues inside the Gompa while demolish was taking place. The Khumjung Gompa Management Committee was careful and took safety considerations while working inside the main Gompa in order to respect the local traditional architecture by engaging the local engineering and architectural as well as local experts.

Local people have demonstrated their strong support and appreciation of the project by voluntarily contributing their labors. Approximately 285 households out of 300 households within Khumjung and Khunde had contributed free labor for 15 days which would be Rs. 18,000 (180 USD) per households and had saved approximately Nepal Rupees 54,00,000 (54,000 USD). Those 15 households come from low income family so they did little contributions for cleaning and other works assigned by the rebuild committee. So the contributions made by local community from Khumjung and Khunde was a significant contribution in kind or cash while rebuild and restoration of Samten Choling Gompa.

CONCLUSION

One of the keys to the successful in rebuilding of Samten Choling Gompa was due to motivation and dedication members with greater knowledge in the rebuild of cultural monument process selected in the rebuild committee. There was a great team work among the rebuild committee based in Khumjung and in Kathmandu and they had carried out their duty in sincerely. Besides that, the local people especially the youth, community-based organizations (CBOs) as partners played crucial roles in local levels to support the rebuild project.

We believe that engaging those local level as partners would yield many lasting positive benefits including reduce costs, expanded impacts, enhanced program sustainability and the cultivation of local capacity to conserve, restore and rebuild of the natural and cultural heritage.

BUDGET DETAILS

The Khumjung Gompa Welfare Development Committee was successful in raising funds from Sherpas within national and international communities and donors like (Everest Future Foundation, American Himalayan Foundation USA, The Greater Himalayas Foundation, Nepal Tourism Board, Nepal Mountaineering Association and Nepal Buddhist Mahayana Center Gompa (Ko-pa Monastery) and many other organizations had contributed to rebuild the Samten Choling Gompa (Khumjung).

No doubt the financial support come from various organizations and the local contribution was a great source for completion of this rebuild project. However, considering the size of the project, unfortunately, was simply a big challenge for the poor villager to fund and manage due to the transportation of metal poles and steel rods, due to heavy weight from the nearest road head to the rebuild site was a time constraint and hiked the wages. Similarly, hiring or recruiting staff workers to take up positons in remote area was not easy so as the high cost for the labor.

The Government support through Village Development Committee and District Development Committee was very limited although the Government had long-term plan to help with recovery from this disaster. So in this case, your contribution to this project is very vital at this point is very important to ensure the successful reconstruction project of the Khumjung Gompa. As we are well aware that the Samten Choling Gompa does not own any land, property or business like others. It does not collect taxes or demand obligatory support from the community and is dependent entirely upon voluntary support from donations from displaying the Yeti Skull.
