

written Dharma materials, they should be burned rather than thrown in the trash. not be placed on top of Dharma books and materials. Licking the fingers to turn a high, clean place separate from more mundane materials. Other objects should not stepped over. They should be covered or protected for transporting and kept in against lower rebirth and to point the way to liberation. Therefore, they should be to your mindstream. After that, as you continue to recite OM, AH, HUM, you can absorbing into the AH and the AH absorbing into you, transmitting their wisdom OM, AH, HUM. Then, you can visualize the letters of the texts (to be burned) treated with respect - kept off the floor and places where people sit or walk - and When burning Dharma texts, it is taught to first recite a prayer or mantra, such as pages is considered bad form as well as negative karma. If it is necessary to dispose of Dharma books contain the teachings of the Buddha; they have the power to protect

in a stupa, tree, or other high, clean place. It has been suggested to put them into a ties, or other holy objects not be burned. Instead, they should be placed with respect small structure like a bird house and then seal the house. Thus, The Extraordinary Aspiration of the Practice of Samantabhadra, also known as The King of Prayers, from the Gandavyūha chapter of the Avatamsaka Sutra (translated by Jinamitra, Surendrabodhi and Yeshe-de circa 900 C.E.), is complete. With palms together I earnestly request:

Please stay with us for eons numberless as atoms of the world You who may actualize parinirvana For the happiness and well-being of all wanderers in samsara

I now dedicate all this for full awakening. By paying homage, offering, and acknowledging my faults, Rejoicing, and requesting that the buddhas stay and teach, Whatever slight positive potential I may have created,

Awakening as fully enlightened ones. May those not yet arisen quickly perfect their minds, And all you gone to freedom in the past, accept my offerings May you buddhas now living in the worlds of ten directions,

Surrounding buddhas gathered beneath a bodhi tree. May they be filled with bodhisattvas Be entirely pure and vast. May all worlds in ten directions.

And may their every Dharma wish be fulfilled May all samsaric beings live in accord with the Dharma Be always well and happy. May as many beings as exist in ten directions

May I always abandon the householder's life. May I practice the bodhisattva way, Remembering my past lives in all varieties of existence, And thus, in each cycle of death, migration, and birth

May I always act without error or compromise, And perfecting the practice of a bodhisattva, With ethical discipline faultless and pure Then, following in the footsteps of all the buddhas,

And be of worldly benefit to them as well. May I guide all wanderers in samsara to the pure bliss of awakening And in the many directions and dimensions of the universe May I ease the suffering in the lower realms

Showing the ways of a bodhisattva. Acting in harmony with the various dispositions of beings, Perfecting the activities of awakening, May I practice constantly for eons to come

May we practice together the same aspirations and activities. Of those whose path is like mine, May I always have the friendship And with body, words, and also mind,

And expertly teaches the bodhisattva way. Who deeply wishes to help me And never displease that excellent friend May I always meet a spiritual mentor

May I make extensive offerings to them. And without pause or discouragement for eons to come, Masters encircled by bodhisattvas, May I always directly see the buddhas

Embody the realizations of a bodhisattva. Illuminate everywhere the teachings that awaken, And practice ardently in all future eons. May I hold within me the Buddha's genuine Dharma,



May I become an endless treasure of good qualities -Gathering limitless pristine wisdom and positive potential. Skillful means, wisdom, samadhi, and liberating stabilizations -While circling through all states of existence

Practicing the activities of awakening. On one atom I shall see Buddha fields numberless as atoms, Inconceivable buddhas among bodhisattvas in every field,

So I, too, will practice for an ocean of eons. I dive into an ocean of buddha-fields, Each an ocean of three times' buddhas in the space of a wisp of hair. Perceiving this in all directions,

Expression that reveals an ocean of qualities in one word, Communication suited to the varied tendencies of beings The completely pure eloquence of all the buddhas, Thus, I am continually immersed in the speech of the buddhas.

Of all buddhas in three times gone to freedom, Into the infinite enlightened speech of the Dharma Who continually turn the wheel of Dharma methods. With strength of understanding I plunge

Such vast activity of all future eons, I shall experience in one moment And I will enter into all eons of the three times. In but a fraction of a second.

I will constantly engage in their inconceivable activity And with the power of the illusion-like stabilization Past, present, and future lions among humans, In one instant I shall see all those awakened beings.

I shall manifest upon one single atom In every direction without exception. Likewise, I shall enter the array of pure buddha-fields The array of pure lands present, past, and future

> Those who reveal nirvana – final, pertect peace. Those sequentially turning the wheels of complete awakening, Those lights of this world who are yet to appear, I shall enter the very presence of all my guides,

The power of all surpassing positive potential The power of love pervading all realms, May I achieve the perfect power of awakening. And through the powers of wisdom, skillful means, and samadhi, The power of supreme knowledge unobstructed by discrimination, The power of always beneficial activity, The power to lead to the great vehicle through every approach, May I achieve the power of swift, magical emanation,

May I free an ocean of beings, May I purify an ocean of worlds I shall perfect the power of the bodhisattva practice. Defusing the power of interfering forces, Crushing the power of disturbing emotions at their root, Purifying the power of all contaminated actions

May I fulfill an ocean of aspirations, May I make offerings to an ocean of buddhas. May I purify an ocean of activities, May I practice without discouragement for an ocean of eons.

May I realize an ocean of pristine wisdom. May I clearly see an ocean of Dharma

I shall fulfill without exception Of all buddhas gone to freedom in the three times everywhere All the diverse aspirations of the awakening practice To awaken fully through this bodhisattva way
